**Fall CE Semester on Blackboard** 

Fall semester Continuing Education (CE) classes are currently available on Blackboard and will remain open until December 13, 2018. Please read the information contained within each course as it will answer many of the questions you may have. The passing score for Fire CE is 70%. The passing score for Medical CE is 80%.

Uniformed personnel shall complete the following CE classes in accordance with Policy F-202.

Each individual is only enrolled in a single section in Blackboard this semester. Due to rostering issues with Blackboard, you will only see a course labeled Fire CE. This section will contain both your Fire and Medical CE for the semester. We have also added a separate section for Fire CE Chief Officer. The rank of Captain and higher are enrolled in this section.

## **Chief Officer CE**

- Water Supply (2 Hours). Water supply principles, groups and supervision of water supply activities.
- Blue Card (2 Hours). This section is to allow Chief Officers that completed Blue Card online training to get 4 hours CE credit for their efforts.

### Fire CE

- Area of Refuge (1 Hour). Define, identify, describe and understand areas of refuge in Highrise/ Midrise buildings.
- Prevention (2 hours). Overview of duties required by Prevention. This class must be completed prior to October 31, 2018 to use credit for the 2018 TCFP renewal for persons holding an Inspector certification.

## **Haz-Mat CE**

Haz-Mat: Fall Pesticides (4 Hours). This class must be completed prior to October 31, 2018 to use credit for the 2018 TCFP renewal.

#### **Medical CE**

- Medical Call Disposition (1 Hour Patient Assessment). Continued Education in PCR and NFIRS, please review carefully – this course contains information that you will be held accountable for in AFD reporting.
- CVA (2 Hours Medical). Review of strokes, stroke centers and the latest treatments.
- Patient Safety (2 Hours Preparatory). Review of all aspects of patient safety.
