Apparatus/Equipment/Projects

- New Engine Update
 - Further revisions/requests to Spartan for revised quote to more meet our needs for an apparatus
 - Spartan quote with revisions: \$594,979
 - Delivery is 180 days compared to 365days
 - Driver/Operators looked over all proposals and wish to go with the Spartan
- Apparatus, hose, ladder and nozzle testing all complete. Several sections of hose did not pass and 8 nozzles did not pass inspection. Nozzles being sent off for evaluation/estimate. No need to replace out of service hose
- Brush Truck 501 currently at Steele Apparatus undergoing repairs from fire that affected the front of the truck.
 Luckily, the fire did not get into the engine compartment/ They are awaiting a couple of parts and once received, it should take about a week to put back together.
- TCESD1 has loaned us one of their brush trucks to use in the meantime.

Countywide AutoAid

- The Austin Fire Department has announced they will pull out of AutoAid if the Travis County/Williamson County Fire Departments cannot agree on incident command terminology that allows more flexibility with AFD's policies and the Blue Card system
- A committee has been setup to go back to working on a new policy to address the concerns of AFD
- IF Austin pulls out of the AutoAid plan, ESD5 will need to work on an individual agreement with AFD on fire responses in/out of ESD5 territory
