There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Travis County Emergency Service District #5 for the year 2023, for the use of the Travis County Emergency Service District #5, an ad valorem tax for maintenance and operations of \$.0.0748 on each \$100 of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the General Fund of Travis County Emergency Service District #5.

There shall be levied and collected upon all taxable property in Travis County Emergency Service District #5 for the year 2023, for the use of the Travis County Emergency Service District #5, an ad valorem interest and sinking of 0.0252 on each \$100 of taxable property so assessed to be credited to the Debt Fund of Travis County Emergency Service District
