
- 2. MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST 2024 BOARD MEETING WERE UNANIMOUSLY APPROVED

Apparatus/Equipment/Projects

- Squad 501
 - Finally arrived in ESD5 / Put into service
 - o Working out some small details of equipment placement, response plans, etc.
- Engine 511 - Unit has been in discussions with LTFR and Sutphen on Engine 511's issues. The unit was identified as not having the right rear end suspension and that it will need to go back to Ohio for the warranty work. Warranty should cover the additional support beam needed, upgrading the suspension, the "bucking" issue with the truck and cracks in the tank. We will send our mechanic to Ohio once all the fixes are done to confirm items were resolved.
- Mobile radios will need to be "touched" by COA radio shop for new template/encryption capabilities scheduled for Sept 9
- Replacement Support Truck gathering bids on like units
- Found backup Internet Service Provider solution through TMobile utilizing a cellular based modem that will tie into our existing hardware
- Replacement Uniform Polo, pants and shorts have been received.
- Traffic Pre-Emption and Station Alerting devices serviced. Only one intersection in service and all other units have something missing or broken. Waiting on replacement parts to arrive and be installed.

Scheduled hydrant flow test training with all crews the week of Sept 9th.

Working on 8 new warehouses at 12306 Wirth Rd and continuing work on the 12300 Wirth Rd warehouses currently in violation.

Coordination with Comm. Howard regarding Estancia West and Old San Antonio developments.

Problem resolution planning regarding Big Valley Multifamily which was discovered to cross the Travis/Hays county lines and issues with access into the complex. This is being coordinated with TCFMO and Hays County ESD 8 which covers the Hays County side.
